Now that you know what things can dissolve (hydawdd), why not try to make things dissolve quicker. Follow the instructions on the sheet to carry out an experiment to discover how.

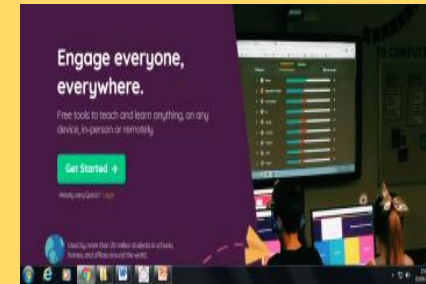


Choose your favourite animal from your 'Top Trumps' cards and write a fact file on it. Remember to include key information, facts, and a description of its appearance.
