Make sure to concentrate on punctuation, on running verbs correctly and on writing about your experiences in chronological order.</p>
<p>Open the document entitled "uplevelling verbs". Firstly, underline all the VERBS in the text (you'll find that they are very boring verbs!) then uplevel the paragraph by improving those verbs. Use a thesaurus to help - if you don't have a thesaurus you could use www.thesaurus.com</p> <p><u>Remember that in the text they are in the past tense and you will need to use the present tense with your thesaurus work.</u></p>	<p>Over the period of a week, record how much time you spend in front of a screen every day (TV, i-pad, laptop, phone, xbox etc) Then record that data on a graph. Perhaps you could compare this data with that of someone else in your home.</p>	<p>Use the internet to research information about Tom Moore the World War Two veteran who has raised over £23 million for the NHS recently. Then write a script of an interview between yourself and this amazing man. You could record this and upload it to your HWB file.</p>	<p>Think of an idea for an adventure story. Think of a title for it and design an appropriate cover for the book. Then write a blurb outlining the story, without giving too much away!</p>
<p>Following on from your adventure story: Think about your main character and draw him/her/it! Then annotate your drawing with adjectives and facts about the character. Finally use all this information to write a detailed character description, remembering to vary your sentence openers and to use plenty of 'waw' words.</p>	<p>Open the document entitled "ffracsiynau a chyfrannedd fractions and proportion".
