## Language, Literacy and Communication Skills

abc

- Learn and reinforce the letters *n, g, b, u, l, w, th, s, d, o*. Provide opportunities for children to practise forming letters in the sand, playdough, by painting and using a pencil.
- Communicate by experimenting with mark making, and learn to write simple words and sentences.
- Understand, recite and discuss a variety of traditional tales.
- Role play in the 'Shop' and 'House'.
- Play language games – Bingo, Lotto, Pairs.
- 'Guided Reading'.
- Discuss and listen to stories relating to Spring, Easter and books relating to the topic (fact and fiction).

## Expressive Arts



- Sing a range of traditional Welsh songs related to the theme.
- Use a variety of equipment / resources to make artefacts from the stories e.g. *the three little pigs' houses, Rapunzel's castle etc.*
- Use a variety of materials, tools and paint to create a painting/model to reinforce letter of the week e.g. *a bird's nest – letter of the week 'n'*.
- Opportunities to construct using different kits e.g. K'nex and Lego.

## Science and Technology



- Learn the life cycle of the frog and the butterfly.
- Prepare and taste a variety of food to reinforce letter of the week and the stories e.g. *tasting porridge from the story 'Goldilocks and the three bears' and preparing banana sandwiches – letter of the week 'b'*.
- Create pictogram graphs and drawings via the JIT programme on Hwb.

## Mathematics and Numeracy

- Reinforce, recognise, name and form numbers 1-20 (and beyond.)
- Match numbers to objects.
- Introduce addition and subtraction.
- Learn mathematical language eg. *big, small, heavy, light, full, half full and empty.*
- Recognise and name 3D shapes.
- Recognise coins of different values and use coins to make totals.
- Learn and practise the method '*one more*' and '*one less*'.

## Health and Well-being



- Learn to hold and use a pencil and scissors.
- Learn different ways of travelling e.g. skipping, jumping, etc.
- Perform movements from traditional Welsh dances.
- Ball skills e.g. controlling, sending and receiving.
- Greetings e.g. 'Sut wyt ti?' 'Bore da!' 'Prynhawn da!'
- Develop the skill of taking turns, listening, working as part of a team and with others.
- Taking care of our bodies – hygiene e.g. brushing our teeth and healthy eating.
- Opportunities to develop independent skills e.g. *putting on their coats/shoes, changing their clothes during PE lessons etc.*

## Humanities



- Discuss the features of Spring and Easter.
- Learn and compare the different houses in our community today. Reinforce the story 'The Three Little Pigs'.
- Learn a variety of stories from the Bible to reinforce letter of the week e.g. 'Noah's Ark' – letter of the week 'n'.
- Learn about our Patron Saint 'St. David' through a variety of activities and songs.
